

## **EDI, change of communication method**

For communication with Swedish Customs the communication method OFTPv2 via TCP/IP are used for electronic declarations.

There are two options for changing the method of communication:

Option 1: Apply for a new technical appendix.

This means:

- New UNB address, i.e. new routing address.
- New OFTP EDI kod
- Regular routines for testing a new technical appendix will be followed
- Transition to the new solution is made at any optional time after production approval
- Notice of termination of the technical appendix which has ceased to be used shall be made

Option 2: Apply for changes to existing technical appendix (unchanged UNB address).

This means:

- New OFTP EDI kod
- Transfers via the production environment can continue as before, while the new communication can be verified through company test environment
- In the normal case, only communication tests will be needed
- Transition of production traffic occurs on a date agreed with Customs' IT department. Telephone contact is established by the IT department during the transition time
- Message flow must be stopped during the transition of production traffic

The application form used for both options is "Begäran om komplettering av tillstånd att lämna elektroniska dokument", - Tv 404.18
